## Alro Steel Plans New Facility in Cedar Rapids, IA

Alro Steel plans to build a US\$20 million office, warehouse and distribution facility in Cedar Rapids, IA. This 199,200-square-foot facility will be the first location for the company in the state of Iowa. This project qualifies under the city's high-quality jobs program, based on the creation of 10 or more jobs at or above Iowa's High Quality Jobs threshold of US\$24.20 per hour, said Caleb Mason, the city's economic development director.



# Aurubis Aurubis Teams Up with SMS to Build Recycling Plant

Aurubis AG and the SMS group will construct a multimetal recycling plant in the United States. As Aurubis announced on November 10, construction of the new Aurubis recycling plant will start in mid-2022 in Augusta, GA. Upon commissioning (scheduled for the first half of 2024), the plant will process about 90,000 tons of complex recycling materials annually. Aurubis is creating more than 100 jobs in the region as part of this project.
